

Buying your train ticket

Depending on how often you travel and the type of ticket you need, there are a number of different ways you can purchase your ticket:

At the ticket office

You can buy the full range of tickets from staffed ticket offices. This includes weekly, monthly and annual season tickets.

At the station

Ticket vending machines sell a range of tickets to popular destinations for immediate use.

From the conductor

If the station has no ticket machine or ticket office,

or the ticket office is closed, you can buy your ticket from the conductor on the train.

Advance, off-peak and standard anytime single and return tickets can be purchased directly from the train operator's website or various other travel sites.

On your mobile

Selected tickets can now be bought through mobile ticketing, providing a quick, easy and convenient way to buy your ticket while on the move.

It is a legal requirement to have a valid ticket or pass.

Travel more, pay less

The more frequently you use the train the more money you can save. For example, if you make the same journey more than three or four times a week, you could find that a weekly ticket saves you up to 20% when compared with the cost of buying a daily ticket. This equates to one free journey a week!

Choosing the right ticket

Single	For a one way journey				
Return	For two trips - one outward and one return				
Cheap Day Return	Travel outside peak periods, returning the same day, for cheaper ticket fares				
Weekly	Unlimited travel between two stations for seven days				
Monthly	Unlimited travel between two stations for one calendar month				
Annual	Unlimited travel between two stations for a whole year. Get 12 weeks' free travel when you buy an annual season ticket!				
Two Together Railcard	Discounted rail travel for two named people travelling together				
16-25 Railcard	Discounted travel rates for young people				
Disabled Persons Railcard	Discounted travel rates for eligible disabled people and adult travel companion				
Friends & Family Railcard	Discounted travel rates for families of up to 4 adults and 4 children aged between 5 and 15				
Senior Railcard	Discounted travel for any person over 60 years of age
